

February start courses

Its not too late to start a full-time course with West Cheshire College! We have many courses that you can enrol for now and start in February...

Advanced level courses in the following areas:

- **Business Award**
- **ICT Practitioners Award**

The National Award programmes are suitable if you have completed a year in sixth form but want a different experience before progressing to University. You will need to have at least 4 GCSEs at grade C or above, including maths and English and at least two AS Levels at grade E or above. UCAS points available for this course range from 40 (Pass) to 120 (Distinction). These courses run from February to June 2010.

- **Engineering**

This is a two-year vocational qualification for those who are interested in the practical application of engineering. You will need at least 4 GCSEs at C or above including maths. Having studied an engineering subject previously will be an advantage.

Intermediate level courses in the following areas:

- **Construction First Diploma**
- **Introduction to Forensics First Diploma**

These courses run from February to June 2010 and will allow you to progress to an advanced course. You will need at least 4 GCSEs at grade D or above including maths or science.

- **Sports Coaching and Fitness Award**

This practical course runs from February to June 2010 and will allow you to progress to an advanced course or into employment. You will need an aptitude for sport and appropriate levels of literacy and numeracy.

Intermediate level courses in the following areas:

● Media (Games Reviewing)

Learn about the games reviewing side of the media industry including media research, publishing reviews, developing game ideas from concept, games and media genres and producing promotional materials.

● Beauty Retail Promotion

This course covers the skills and techniques used in 'beauty' retail environments such as providing make-up and facial treatments, display techniques, modelling skills and improving self awareness and confidence.

There are also opportunities to join existing intermediate courses in the following areas:

● Childcare

● Retail

You will need at least 4 GCSEs at D or above to undertake these courses.

Introductory level course:

● Army Preparation

This is a 12-week course starting in February. It is aimed at those who wish to join the Army. You need to be referred to this course by an Army Recruitment Officer.

There are also opportunities to join existing introductory programmes in the following areas.

- Painting and Decorating
- Carpentry and Joinery
- Beauty Therapy
- Childcare
- IT@Work

You will need at least 2 GCSEs at grade G or above to undertake these courses.
